Arthur L. Frank MD, PhD is currently Professor of Public Health and Professor of Medicine at Drexel University in Philadelphia, USA. Trained in internal medicine and occupational medicine Dr. Frank has been an academic physician for more than forty years, working in such areas as occupational lung disease, occupational and environmental cancers, and agricultural safety and health. He was trained at the Mount Sinai School of Medicine in New York and at The Mount Sinai Hospital, and received his PhD in Biomedical Sciences from the City University of New York. He has chaired three academic departments and is currently Chair Emeritus of the Department of Environmental and Occupational Health at the Dornsife School of Public Health at Drexel. He has been a frequent visitor to India and for many years has worked with colleagues at Maulana Azad Medical College and has done international work in Asia, Europe, and South America.
